Dear Senior Plans participant:

You recently received a letter from Medco stating that you will be automatically enrolled in a Medco Medicare Prescription Plan for GuideStone for 2012. You don't need to do anything in response to this letter. You are still enrolled in your GuideStone health plan and will be enrolled for 2012 unless you decide not to continue your GuideStone health plan coverage.

Effective January 1, 2012, you will see a few changes to your Senior or Senior Plus health plan due to the fact that the prescription drug portion of your plan is becoming a Medicare Part D plan. The attached "*2012 Senior Plans: What's changing?*" explains more about the changes to the plans. Your employer has likely already informed you of these changes. The most immediate change you will notice is that you'll often pay lower copays for generic prescriptions filled at either a retail pharmacy or through mail order.

One result of the transition to a Medicare Part D plan is that the plans will be subject to notifications required by the Center for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) – like the one you recently received from Medco. In December, you will receive a Welcome Kit from Medco with your new ID cards and additional information about your prescription drug plan. As always, if you get this or any other notice and are unsure if you need to do anything, feel free to call GuideStone to discuss it.
